Print out this sheet and bring it with you to your next visit to the Tompkins County Public Library. Use the clues below to discover all the great things you can find at your library! You can always ask for help from a library staff person – we are here to help! Do it by yourself or with a friend or family member!

All of the items below can be found in the Youth Services Department

1.	Find the kids' magazines. (A clue: Look for the statue of the sheep.) What is on the cover of the latest copy of Dig magazine?
2.	Where can you find animals painted all over the walls?
3.	Find the Picture Books. They are in alphabetical order by the author's last name. Find 2 authors' names in the "S" section and write them here.
4.	Find the reference desk. Ask the person sitting at the desk where the books about pandas are. Tell them you want to know facts about pandas. Write down a title of a panda book you found in the Non-Fiction section. Bonus question: Write down the call number of the title you chose.
<u> </u>	Count the number of computers we have in the Youth Services Department. What kind of computers do we have?
6.	Find the Self Check out machine. Figure out what you can do there. What do you need to use this machine?
